



Senior Research Analyst (Senior Conference Producer) – Bioenergy Series

The role:

Reporting to the Head of the Bioenergy Series, the Senior Research Analyst will be expected to work on the development of conference agendas (including several large scale events) and topic areas. The role will be focused on conducting research projects, producing independently researched agendas and conference products, confirming speakers and liaising with key companies & associations in the sector.

Green Power Conferences run events across the globe. The Bioenergy Series (see details attached) currently runs events in Rotterdam, Singapore, São Paulo & San Francisco; travel is a likely part of this role.

An event researcher is the master of multi tasking; researching new topics, bringing the conference project team together and continuously on the lookout for potential new speakers and partners. Ultimately the relationships the researcher builds with speakers and other industry contacts play a key role in developing new ideas and establishing a good reputation for Green Power Conferences.

Face to face contact is excellent for developing these relationships and you will be encouraged to organize meetings with relevant companies and speakers at events you attend whenever you can. Time management and a high level of organization are essential as the candidate will be responsible for a number of time sensitive products.

The candidate will be expected to negotiate with external contacts and stake holders. Confidence and the ability to deal with senior level representatives is a must. This role would especially suit someone with strong communication skills (written and oral) and strong research skills.

Key responsibilities:

- Producing 4-5 (2 large scale and elements of other events in the series) high quality, independently researched conferences per annum with a logical and complete agenda which is an accurate representation of the industry and current state of the market segment to enable attendees to make informed business decisions
- Understand industries and their value chain quickly
- To accurately position and identify the audience for an event
- To obtain the maximum marketing potential for an event: deadlines must be met
- To communicate all the necessary information to other members of the team to maximise the revenue and success any one event can achieve
- To take in information on the renewable energy industry not only for their own projects but for the team as a whole
- Business development of new industry organisations, event ideas and event formats
- Manage all aspects of the process with a good knowledge of how an event runs
- Topic and format generation – contributing new event topics (add to the hot list) and bringing different aspects to the conference
- Develop external relationships with associations, new businesses, potential co-located events
- Have a greater understanding of the conference process and give input into the process-finding ways to improve the event and the processes used to run it
- Develop a coaching ability and in time to be mentoring new staff

- Understand the budget; contribute to managing the budget and controlling costs
- Give excellent service to speakers, sponsors and delegates, building individual relationships on event series that encourage continued business

Requirements:

- 2-3 years experience in a similar role
- 1st or 2:1 degree
- Interest in the renewable energy and climate change sector
- Fresh ideas and an imaginative approach
- Ability to work within a team environment
- Strong IT skills
- Languages not essential but useful
